THE DROUGHT HITS US AGAIN



In the north of the country, in Maramureș especially, we are facing a drought. Not a drop of rain has fallen in the last three months. The ground is cracked and the crops are compromised. The supply of water to households is based on a schedule, in each village people receive water only 4 hours a day. The water level in the wells has dropped significantly, people are taking more mud than water from the wells.

"Last year it was the same situation, during this period the crops looked good, the humidity was satisfactory. After 3 months of drought we had nothing to do. We hope that this year history will not repeat itself because it would be very difficult to recover after two identical years. All we can do is to increase the price of vegetables and grains," said Ion Gheorghe, a local farmer.

Town halls have banned watering gardens and washing cars with water from the water network. The local police are checking compliance with this decision. The water level in the reservoirs has dropped a lot and the hydro plants cannot operate at full capacity. The Cernavodă nuclear power plant operates with only one reactor, so the price of electricity will increase. It's a tough situation, and some relief are expected. The authorities are planning further measures if the drought doesn't end, and people say that if it rains in the next 2 days the crops may recover.

FLOODS IN THE NORTH OF THE COUNTRY

A new flood hits Romania, in North. It has been raining continuously for two days, the rain melting the snow deposited last week. Hydrologists issued, on Monday, two yellow and orange code warnings for rivers in the northwest and west. The spilled waters have already created big problems in Satu Mare. A red flood code is issued there, and the flow of the Crasna River may exceed the danger level. River waters flooded over 500 hectares of cultivated land.

The other cities sent rescuers to help and the civil protection service intervened with boats and helicopters to rescue those isolated by water. At the same time, the army and gendarmerie acted by building sandbag dams to prevent water from entering other houses. 54 households were flooded, 13 people died, and 102 people were evacuated being accommodated in the gym in Puhoaiete village. They received food, blankets and mattresses.

Mrs. Maria was rescued from the roof together with her cat. "I lost all my belongings, the chickens and pigs drowned, the dog swam to a neighbor's house. All I have left is this cat," she tells reporters.

The president of the country, Mr. Klaus Iohannis, visited the affected people and promised to help them rebuild their households.
